Award**

The Division for Learning Disabilities (DLD) of the Council for Exceptional Children is pleased to announce the availability of the Marva Collins Diversity Award. This award honors a special education teacher who makes a significant impact in the education of children and youths with Learning Disabilities from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds. The award consists of a \$200 stipend and free registration to the DLD National Conference. Nominations for this award are due August 30th of each year.

REQUIREMENTS

All nominees must be full-time special education teachers. The recipient must attend the DLD National Conference to receive the award. Although nominees need not be members of DLD, nominations must come from members of DLD.

NOMINATION INFORMATION

To nominate someone (self-nominations are accepted), please provide the following information:

- ★ Name, address, email, and phone number of nominee;
- ★ Name, DLD-CEC member number, address, phone, and email of nominator;
- ★ A description (no more than 500 words) of how the nominee has affected the lives and education of children and youths with Learning Disabilities from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds, either through direct services, community and parental involvement, curriculum and instruction, research, etc.
