Jeannette Fleischner Awards

Outstanding Contribution to the Field of LD

The Division for Learning Disabilities (DLD) of the Council for Exceptional Children makes the Jeannette Fleischner Awards to honor those who advance the field of Learning Disabilities through direct services, policy development, community service, research, or organizational leadership. As many as three awards may be given annually to recognize a variety of types of contributions. The award consists of \$500 in cash, up to \$500 in travel expenses to help defray the cost of travel to receive the award at the CEC Annual Convention, and an article describing the individual's contribution in the DLD newsletter, *New Times for DLD*. Nominations may be made by any DLD member, any DLD subdivision, or by the DLD executive board. Remember direct service providers can be nominated!

Please provide the following data about yourself and the individual whom you are nominating:

- ◆ Name, address, phone number, and tax ID number of nominee;
- ◆ Curriculum vita of nominee;
- ◆ Name and DLD (CEC) member number of nominator; and
- ◆ Address & phone(s) of nominator.
- ◆ A description of how the nominee has influenced or affected Learning Disabilities through any of the following: enhancing knowledge, influencing policy, shaping research, encouraging community involvement, enhancing awareness, or improving service delivery through teacher training, assessment, curriculum, instruction, or research. Three letters of support highlighting the reason(s) for the nomination (note: two letters must be from professionals).
